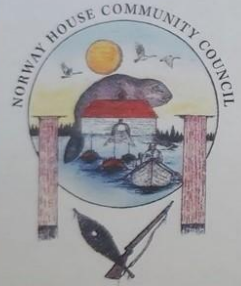

Community Update Announcement April 4, 2020

As you are aware, these are the steps that are being taken in response to COVID 19 Pandemic:

- A letter has been sent to the Minister of Defense, a joint initiative with Cross Lake, for military help for both communities
- There are a group of men who are harvesting wild food and will be distributed to the community – fish has been given out to each household and who are continuing their deliveries, goose and duck hunting will also be done when weather permits
- Turkeys will be given out before Easter weekend for each household
- For the road block, which is located at Pine Creek, only community members will be allowed in and everyone who returning to the community must self isolate – passes will be given out to monitor who leaves the community for essential reasons (Medical, hunting, fishing, ferry operators, PDC)
- The York Boat Inn is currently being used for people who need to self- isolate and meals will be provided.
- All recommendations are being considered and there are daily meetings taking place
- At this time, there will be more enforcement regarding self-isolation and if there is non-compliance, they will be forced to mandatory quarantine at any of the identified locations
- Effective today, April 4, 2020, there will be a community curfew in effect from 12:00am-6am, No one should be out after 12:00am
