## **Guidelines for Travel North of 53**

**Effective May 13th, 2020**

**In the event, that community members must travel for the following reasons they will be given a pass and sign the travel agreement form.**

**Essential travel means: (this is on-going and on as needed basis)**

- Dental appointments, optometrist, vehicle maintenance including drop off or pick up for repairs, medical appointments, other situations.

**Day trips (12 hour) to Thompson for general purposes- passes will be given out for Friday May 15, Saturday May 16, or Sunday May 19, 2020;**

**Weekend travel is allowed North of 53, excluding Flin Flon and The Pas (an exception will be made for those who have child visitation) with passes;**

**NHCN members and other family relations will be welcome to come into the community to visit for the long weekend; passes will be provided to the host family;**

**In the event that a COVID-19 case occurs in the North of 53 no travel will be allowed and the road will be closed and open only for essential supplies to be delivered to the community.**

People who travel for these reasons will also have to call Public Health to provide their names for self-monitoring at (204) 359-8922 at extensions 353 for Adelaide Duncan, 354 for Kendra Simpson and 355 for Amber Paupanekis. Alternate Cell #204-301-0386.

- If you do not call that number within 4 days of your return your name will be placed on the self-isolation list and you will not be allowed in any public place.
- People who have violated the terms in previous trips will not be given passes.
