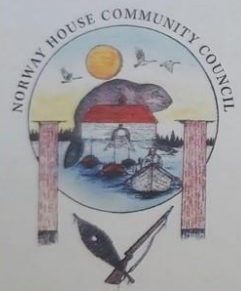

**Effective June 2, 2020**

## **Phase 2 – Relaxing Restrictions**

- 1) Passes are still required to leave Norway House for North of 53. Travel permits will be required for South of 53.**
- 2) Visitors coming to Norway House will require a visitor's permit that must be picked up by a family member and all people will self-monitor**
- 3) Travel within Manitoba you will self-monitor for symptoms of COVID-19. Self-monitoring will be supported by term employees from the NHCN Public Health who will call people who have travelled randomly**
- 4) People who travelled or are returning from outside of the province will be required to self-isolate for 14 days**
- 5) Gym is reopened to 6 persons at a time**
- 6) Curfew between 12:00am to 6:00am in effect for 17 and under.**
- 7) Public gatherings such as social gatherings, worship, weddings, and funerals shall remain at maximum of 25 people indoor and 50 people outdoor**
- 8) Public food establishments, such as restaurants will open to 50% capacity**
- 9) Food and bake sales will continue and outdoor garage sales can begin following the gathering limit of 50 people and permits can be picked up by Quarantine Officer**

**All other safe measures remain in place – physical distancing of two meters, hand sanitizing/washing.**

**PLEASE REMEMBER IN THE EVENT THERE IS AN INCREASE OF ACTIVE COVID-19 CASES ALL RESTRICTIONS WILL BE PUT BACK INTO PLACE.**
