



## NORWAY HOUSE CREE NATION CHIEF & COUNCIL ELECTION 2022

Norway House Cree Nation held an election (the “Election”) for its Chief and Councillors on March 7<sup>th</sup>, 2022, according to the rules and provisions of the Norway House Cree Nation Election Procedures Act, 2005, (the “EPA”).

On March 8<sup>th</sup>, 2022, the Electoral Officer posted the results of the Election.

Pursuant to Section 7.1 of the EPA within thirty days after the Electoral Officer posted the results of an election, an elector may under enumerated grounds appeal an election.

An appeal dated March 10, 2022, (the “Appeal”) was received on April 1, 2022 by the Electoral Officer

As per Section 7.2 of the Norway House Cree Nation Election Procedures Act, 2005, (the “EPA”), “Upon receipt of an appeal, the Electoral Officer shall forthwith cause a meeting of the Appeal Committee to be convened”.

Therefore, this notice will be as such, for the Appeal Committee to set a meeting as per section 7.3 of the EPA to review, consider and determine the result of the appeal received.

**7.2** The **Appeal Committee** shall hear the appeal within thirty (30) days of the filing of the notice of appeal and shall deliver its decision within ten (10) days of the hearing appeal. The **Appeal Committee** shall not be bound by any rules of evidence. The decision of the **Appeal Committee** shall be final and binding. Any appeal to a Court of Law shall be founded in law and not in fact.

Where the **Appeal Committee** finds that a **candidate** or **candidates** have not been elected to office in accordance with these procedures, that candidate whose election violated these procedures shall vacate the office to which he/she was elected, and the **Electoral Officer** shall hold a nomination meeting and election for the vacant office or offices in accordance with Article 4 of these procedures.
