

Norway House Cree Nation Treaty and York Boat Days 2022

Important Notice to Henry and Maryann Memorial York Boat Race participants.

Please be advised of rule additions to Norway House Cree Nation, Henry and Maryann Muminawatum Memorial York Boat Race.

York Boat Days Committee announced and invited community members to attend planning meetings that were held on April 19, May 11, and June 8, 2022. During the meeting of May 11, and June 8, 2022 some rule changes were introduced and after discussion they went to vote and were supported unanimously.

- 1. a) Teams will be allowed to have one (1) Import
 - b)Teams participating in the Henry and Maryanne Memorial York Boat Races must provide proof of residency of the community they're rowing for. (Residency Clause: You must have resided in that community for six (6) months prior to the event (February 1, 2022).
- 2. In the event of another pandemic, "pandemic or community emergency ie: forest fire" Norway House Treaty and York Boat Days Committee reserve the right to implement measures to protect participants and the community.

We have seen a decline in participation in our own nation and other communities, and the committee hopes to see more participation in 2022 Treaty and York Boat Days.
