HOW TO REGISTER FOR NHCN ELECTRONIC VOTING 2026

- ◆ To use electronic voting please see attached the step-by-step guide, or visit the OneFeather voting website below, once on the onefeather site click the sign up now to activate your account <https://www.onefeather.ca/nations/norwayhouse>
- ◆ If you have already previously registered with onefeather to vote, you may still have an active account and can use it to vote this time.
- ◆ You will receive an email from onefeather confirming your voter registration, please check your junk or spam email to ensure you receive it.
- ◆ **You will need a valid email address & your 10 digit treaty number to register, this must be entered with no spaces and accurate or the system will not validate you as the elector.**
- ◆ Please read and follow all instructions from onefeather for the electronic voting process in your email.
- ◆ When the voting event opens, you will receive an email notification, which contains your PIN and a link to the voting event.
- ◆ Electronic Voting will open May 1, 2026 9am-6pm (Manitoba time)
- ◆ Electronic voting is safe, secure. It uses identity verification, encryption, unique PINs, and strict privacy protections to ensure a fair and accurate election.
